## WHAT'S THE SCOOP? RECAP OF THE PTA MEETING:

During the last virtual meeting we discussed our new platform of communication, 2022-2023 tuition & registration fees, uniforms, and school clubs:

1. Remind- effective Feb. 11<sup>th</sup> we will streamline all communication through the Remind App. An email has been sent to all parents. Please download and accept the invitation to be included on this platform.
2. AIP has not raised tuition & registration fees in 3 years. With the rising cost of good and services, building maintenance, competitive rates with other schools, and an increase in educational resources, please see the prices for former and new families: Registration/re enrollment fee: \$325 per child (this covers books, supplies, & insurance) AIP will purchase ALL books/supply materials for the 2022-2023 school year. Tuition: K3/K4 \$730mo, K5-8<sup>th</sup> \$730mo (with meal plan), \$680mo (without meal plan). Siblings: \$700mo (with meal plan), \$650mo (without meal plan). 3. Our payment options have changed to a Pay Ahead System. 1<sup>st</sup> Tuition payment for the academic year 2022-2023 will be due in July and the last payment will be rendered in April.
