Important GET UP AND DANCE Information:

Attendance: Dancers are required to attend all classes. If your dancer is not able to make a class it is your responsibility to notify Director|Dance Instructor – Ms. Joi as soon as possible. Good attendance is imperative and absences and tardiness can hinder the dancer. Dancers should always be prepared for class/practice. We understand that emergencies and things happen but we just ask that you inform us as soon as possible. Sending a quick email to [_onpointedancelife@gmail.com](mailto:onpointedancelife@gmail.com) is top preference.

Proper Dance Attire for Class: Dancers are **required** to wear all black dance attire. Here are examples of what is acceptable: black fitted tank top, black leotard, black dance shorts, black biketard, black leggings and black capri leggings. NO baggy clothes, printed clothes or school clothes. Dancers will also need black jazz shoes by their second class in October. A list of local dance attire stores and dance materials are further below

Additional Dance Materials for Class: All dancers on Level One and Two Dance Club will also need a small journal which will serve the purpose as their dance reflective journal and they will be required to bring this every week to class.

Bad Weather/Emergency: In the event that weather is extremely bad – an executive decision will be made by Ms. Joi and AIP. Parents will be notified via group message or email if a class will be canceled. If there are any other emergencies outside of bad weather parents will be notified in a very timely manner as well.

GET UP AND DANCE Class Rules:

Parents are **NOT** allowed in class unless approved by Ms. Joi.

Dancers should come dressed and prepared for class prior to start time.

Dancers are allowed to bring water or juice only to practice. **NO additional snacks will be allowed.** Chewing gum is not allowed during class..

Hair should always be pulled back away from face neatly such as: bun, ponytail, braids, etc.

Dancers will always treat their instructor and fellow dance sisters with respect and love. Disrespect will **NOT** be tolerated within the Get Up and Dance Program.

Dancers do not have permission to leave class until after being officially dismissed by Ms. Joi.
