WHAT'S THE SCOOP? 2022-2023 ENROLLMENT!

Open Enrollment for the 2022-2023 is underway and the response to Early Bird Registration was fantastic! For those planning to reenroll into AIP next year, please be sure to reserve your slot. Over half of AIP has reenrolled and we have welcomed 10 new families, so far, for the 2022-2023 academic school year. Grades K4-4th and 6th are **70-85% full**. Please remember, we are unable to reserve slots verbally. All slots must be reserved with the reenrollment form and applicalbe payment. Reenrollment, post early registration, is now \$200 for the initial fee with a balance of \$125 due in July.

1. If you submitted a renrollment payment but did not complete the renrollment form please do so now to complete the entire enrollment process.
2. Please make sure you schedule physicals and retrieve updated hearing and immunization records for the upcoming school year.
3. Please remember that tuition, for the 2022-2023 academic year, will be due on the 20th of each month beginning July 20th.
4. There is a Mandatory Open house on 8/2/2022. The first day of school is 8/3/2022.
