

WHAT DO YOU NEED?



1=6qt clear shoe container. Containers may be found at retailers like the Dollar store, Walmart, and Target.



Wrapping paper and tape.



A Sharpie.



And ten dollars in a labeled envelope!

WHAT ARE THE STEPS?

- Place the items in the container. Secure the lid on the container.
- Wrap the container in sturdy wrapping paper Twice.
- Label the top of the container, in marker, with the Gender and Age:
Ex: Boy, 8 years or Girl, 12 years
- Label an envelope with your child's name and place the \$10, for shipping, inside to turn in with the gift. Do not attach it to the gift.
- Say a Prayer for the recipient.
- Bring the completed project to school on November 29th.

GIFT BOX ITEM EXAMPLES

Something Fun:

doll, stuffed animal, small musical instrument, small game, playdoh, slime, toy cars, gift card, jump rope, action figures, rubrics cube, yo-yo, dinosaurs, building blocks, playing cards

Something to Achieve:

books, crossword puzzles, coloring book w/crayons, diary, pens, pencils, non-liquid watercolor sets, chalk,

Something for Looks:

hairbows, bracelets, chap stick, purse, wallet, water bottle, shirt, team hat, earrings, watch, nail clipper set

Something they Need:

comb, hairbrush, toothbrush, slippers, socks, t-shirts, hat-scarf-mittens, toothbrush set (no toothpaste), deodorant (stick), mirror, pajamas
